

Conditions of participation for the Hands-On Project 2017 „Teaching the Global Goals“

Please read the following conditions and the detailed information on the Hands-On Project before you apply:

The following conditions are valid for the Hands-On Project 2017 “Teaching the Global Goals” on the domain www.alumniportal-deutschland.org. The project is organised by the Alumniportal Deutschland. It starts with the application period on 24.05.2017 and ends with the award ceremony on 26.07.2017.

Application:

Only teams of 2-3 members are eligible to apply for the Hands-On Project 2017 “Teaching the Global Goals”. The application period is between 24.05.2017 and 11.06.2017.

Every person who is registered with the Alumniportal Deutschland and a member of the attendant community group “Praxisprojekt 2017/ Hands-on Project 2017” can participate. Participation is free of charge.

Teams should register for the project via e-mail (hands-on-project@alumniportal-deutschland.org), giving the names of the team members, their e-mail-addresses and the link to the group that the team has created on the Alumniportal specifically for the Hands-on Project.

In the case of a large amount of applications, participating teams will be selected according to the entries in their personal profiles on the Alumniportal as well as the suitability and practicability of their chosen topics. Updated personal profiles on the Alumniportal are given priority.

Employees of the Alumniportal Deutschland and minors are not eligible for application. There is no right of appeal.

Selection of winners and prizes:

The selection of the winning teams and the awarding of prizes will be carried out by a jury of experts. The jury will assess and reward the contributions according to fixed criteria. The jury's decision is final. There is no right of appeal.

Information on the prizes can be found in the document “Detailed Information”. The winning team will be determined after the conclusion of the project. The prizes will be awarded individually after selection of the winners. All organisational details concerning the prizes will be communicated personally with the winners after the end of the project.

All participants who submit a result of their team's work at the end of the competition will receive a certificate of participation.

The organisers aim to realize one of the concepts submitted by the teams after the conclusion of the competition, but this is subject to the financial scope of the project. Winning the Hands-On Project's competition does not amount to a claim to the realisation of the concept. Submitted concepts should follow the general principles of economic viability and efficiency.

Notification of winners:

All winners will be notified via e-mail; there will also be publications in various places on the Alumniportal and externally.

Publications and Rights of Use:

All participants agree to the use of work results (documents, files, texts, images, videos, concepts, design drafts) that were produced and submitted for the Alumniportal's Hands-On Project in publications. Participants' names will always be quoted as originators of the respective product. Publications can include:

- The Alumniportal Deutschland (www.alumniportal-deutschland.org)
- Internet and print media of the Alumniportal Deutschland's cooperation partners (Alexander von Humboldt-Foundation, DAAD, Goethe-Institut, GIZ)
- Social media applications that are used by the Alumniportal Deutschland (e.g. Facebook, Twitter)
- Coverage in newspapers and on their websites, in magazines and online media.

By submitting their concepts, teams undertake to comply with copyrights. The submitted concepts may not infringe on the rights of third parties (in particular concerning copyrights and neighbouring rights). Should any third parties still allege any infringement of their rights, the participants will release the Alumniportal and its cooperation partners from all claims addressed at the Alumniportal and its cooperation partners.

By submitting a concept, the authors (participants in the competition) agree to a possible realisation of their concept by the Alumniportal Deutschland (or by third parties commissioned by the Alumniportal). The authors shall assign all assignable rights to the work results (i.e. all work that is created or procured in performance of the Hands-On Project 2017, especially concepts, studies, drafts, documentation, articles, information, records, illustrations, drawings, plans, calculations, materials, photos, image files and other visual presentations) to the Alumniportal Deutschland. If the assignment of rights is not permissible by law, the authors shall grant the Alumniportal Deutschland an irrevocable, worldwide and exclusive right – for the duration of statutory copyright and other property rights – to use all work results, including commercial use outside the measure. The Alumniportal Deutschland's rights of use shall include the right to use the work results of the Hands-On Project 2017 without limitations with respect to time, content and location. The Alumniportal Deutschland shall further be entitled to assign to third parties the rights of use granted or to grant sublicences in these rights of use to third parties. Copyrights remain with the authors.

There is no right of appeal.

Legal Disclaimer:

The Alumniportal Deutschland reserves the right to limit the accessibility of this Hands-On Project or to suspend it temporarily, especially for technical reasons. This will not result in claims against the Alumniportal Deutschland.

The Alumniportal Deutschland is not liable for material defects and defects of title concerning the prizes.
